

HIDE-A-WAY LAKE BURN PERMIT APPLICATION

(Burn Permit is valid for 2 months)

I understand that I have an alternative to burning. With the Monday trash collection, yard debris can be bagged or bundled into four foot lengths or less and placed next to the trash can. The bundles cannot exceed a foot in diameter and the total amount of yard debris to be collected cannot be more than a 4' by 4' area. If the yard debris is more than a 4' by 4' area or needs to be removed prior to the weekly garbage pickup, yard debris can be brought to the landfill in Millard. For operating hours and restrictions, contact the Millard Landfill at 601-795-2500.

I affirm that I have read and understand the restrictions for outside burning in HIDE-A-WAY LAKE, below:

Burning of yard debris (leaves, limbs, and pine straw only) is allowed but restricted. Lot Owners must obtain permission to burn yard debris by obtaining a burn permit from the Club Office. The following criteria are to be adhered to:

- When burning, please use caution and be considerate of your neighbors regarding wind direction and smoke from the fire. Should smoke begin to linger and cause a nuisance, burning must be ceased per Covenant 51: Noxious or Offensive Activities.**
- Yard debris (leaves, limbs, and pine straw only) must be dry to burn and cannot be wet or damp.**
- Distance to the nearest structure (home, shed, bulkhead, wooden structures) must be a minimum of 25' and a minimum of 10' from the resident's property line. If this is not possible, the Security Officer or HAWL staff will evaluate the proposed area to allow burning.
- To prevent the possibility of fire spreading, it is recommended that a burn not be conducted in steady winds.
- Burning on your property is only allowed in a 4' x 4' area or in a barrel and the fire pile must not exceed a 4'W X 4'L X 3'H.
- A HAWL resident over the age of 18 years will be present at the burn site for the duration of the burn including when debris is still smoldering.
- HAWL resident affirms that he/she has sufficient knowledge, equipment, including a garden hose adequate to reach the burn site, and the ability to safely complete the burn without danger to other property.
- In the interest of homestead and for safety purposes all fueling of any burn pile within the hours of 6 pm and 6 am is prohibited. A fire started prior to 6 pm does not have to be extinguished but may not be fueled after that time.
- Burning is prohibited on any nationally recognized holiday.
- Property owner **MUST** comply with any county mandated BURN BAN.
- Open Burning is not allowed in ditches or on common property.
- There is no burning of household garbage, tree stumps and other refuse (for example, building materials).

Any violations of the above rules will result in an administrative fee issued to the property owner.

Note: Burn Permit must be posted in a visible location.

I further affirm that I will abide by all of these restrictions.

I understand that HIDE-A-WAY LAKE CLUB, Inc. and HIDE-A-WAY Property Owners Associations, Inc. will not be held responsible and that I must assume all responsibility for any damage as a result of my actions under this permit.
