## Hide-A-Way Lake Club, Inc. Vehicle Registration "Automatic Tag with Decal" **VEHICLE MUST STOP AT GATE**

## When entering and exiting the community, at both the Main Front Gate and Southgate, please maintain a speed of no more than 15 mph.

I, the Property Owner, do hereby register the following vehicle, which is owned by the Property Owner or a Registered Resident, to be used in the Hide-A-Way Lake Community. **The decal and automatic tag are a numbered set and both the tag and decal must be displayed on the vehicle to which they are registered.** The decal set is the property of HAWL Club, Inc. and is nontransferable for any reason.

- Placement of Automatic Tag Tag is to be placed on inside top passenger side of windshield (opposite side of decal) below any strips of window tint and from any antenna in the windshield. Proper placement is the responsibility of the property owner. Any misplacement will result in having to purchase a new decal at full price.
  - <u>IMPORTANT: Before attaching the automatic tag to the windshield, it is highly</u> recommended to first test the correct tag location by taping the tag to the windshield then driving through the automated lane. Once you confirm the proper location, attach the tag on the windshield. Note, on some vehicles the tag cannot be read when placed inside the vehicle. An alternative is to purchase the automated tag that can be placed on the outside of the vehicle (such as on the headlight or windshield). Ask HAWL Office employee for more information.
- HAWL decal (yellow circle) is to be placed on the <u>inside</u> driver side of windshield near the bottom of the windshield.
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop when approaching the gate. This is for your safety. The arms at the Front Main Gate will only allow **one gate arm** to open at a time. The vehicle with the automatic tag must completely stop for reader to activate. Stop at the stop sign located in the center of entry lanes.
- Current vehicle insurance (in the property owner's and/or Other Occupant's name) showing the VIN number of the vehicle must be provided along with the driver's license matching the vehicle's insurance (copied for HAWL Office file). I further understand that vehicle insurance must be maintained consistently for this vehicle. A copy of the vehicle registration form is not needed; however, information which must be provided includes license plate number, body style, make, model, year, color, and vehicle serial number (VIN). All information must be provided prior to the Automatic Tag/Decal purchase.
- I understand that whenever a car decal is replaced, the vehicle is sold, or I move from Hide-A-Way Lake, both the HAWL Decal and the Automatic Decal must be removed from the vehicle and turned into the HAWL Office.
- This vehicle will be operated only by a properly licensed person, in a lawful manner, and in accordance with the rules set down by the Hide-A-Way Lake Club, Inc. I agree to assume full financial responsibility for any and all damages or injury resulting from the operation of the described vehicle while within the Hide-A-Way Lake Community. I also understand that any penalties which may be assessed for traffic/rules violations will be charged to my account. PROPERTY OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL ACTIONS OF THEIR OTHER OCCUPANTS/REGISTERED RESIDENTS.
- The Automatic Tag with Decal is the property of Hide-A-Way Lake Club, Inc. and is non-transferable, for any reason. Hide-A-Way Lake Office is authorized to verify any information submitted and if any false statement is made or if the tag is placed on any vehicle other than the registered vehicle, the Property Owner will lose the automatic gate privilege to enter the community and will pay an administrative fine.
- The life expectancy of the automatic tag depends on a number of factors not limited to age of the tag, vehicle's interior temperature, humidity, exposure to sunlight, etc. Replacement of a nonworking tag is the property owner's responsibility and will be done at the property owner's expense.
- Property owners and residents who have an automatic tag with decal must be a member in good standing with the club for the tag to stay activated. The automatic tag can be deactivated for outstanding issues. Those violators will have to use the visitor lane.
- Automatic tags for a company vehicle may be purchased by the property owner as long as permission
  is obtained from the company on their company letterhead stating that the vehicle may be driven by
  the requesting individual.

IMPORTANT: Before adhering the automated tag to the windshield, it is highly recommended for you to test the correct placement of the tag before attaching it on the windshield to ensure the sensor can read the tag. To test, simply tape the tag to the windshield and drive through the automated lane. Once you confirm the correct location, then attach the tag to the windshield.
