## MANAGER'S REPORT – Bruce Devillier

- 1. The audit/review of all financial statements and tax returns for the fiscal year of October 1, 2022, to September 30, 2023, is scheduled with Angela Hertzog of Grantham Poole, Certified Public Accountants.
- 2. VIF, LLC is wrapping up the project of bulkheading and replacing docks at the Lodge Marina. At the West Marina, the existing older docks and the bulkhead will be replaced. This area will begin this month.
- 3. Quotes were received last month to purchase water meters and valves as part of our replacement project. A resolution is forthcoming.
- 4. The Maintenance Department is scheduled this month to clean and seal the main splillway. Tar was ordered from Home Depot. The cost of this capital project is \$2,050.71.
- 5. The 34 replacement pool lounge chairs were ordered from Kozyard for a total capital purchase of \$5,098.32.

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- 6. Replacement pool umbrellas and stands were ordered from Amazon for a total capital purchase of \$1,535.27.
- 7. Replacement chairs for the restaurant deck were ordered from Home Depot. The capital purchase price was \$3,290.73.
- 8. Replacement tables for the restaurant deck were ordered from Home Depot for a capital purchase price of \$2,140.94.
- 9. The Southgate trial period for extended hours began Monday, October 2, 2023. Southgate will be open continually Monday Friday from 5:00 am 9:00 pm. Vehicle usage data will be collected to finalize if the hours of operation will be adjusted. This decision will be made at the Board's Executive Meeting in December. Data will be available at the HAWL Office and published in the upcoming *Echoes*.
- 10. The lake will be lowered in January 2024 for a formal engineer inspection that is regulated by MDEQ.
- 11. A Community Meet and Greet with the General Manager, Blood Drive, and Goodwill Express Donation Station was held Saturday, November 4, 2023. Thank you to all of the property owners who participated.
