## CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

### STUDENT APPLICANTS MUST:

- 1. Be a resident of Hide-A-Way Lake living with the property owner for at least 1 (one) academic year.
- 2. Be graduating high school or equivalent (includes students enrolled in an accredited high school, private school, private or parochial school; students who are homeschooled; students otherwise engaged in official high school accredited programs.)
- 3. Have graduated the previous year but have not attended any academic institution. Deadline for these applicants is on year form high school graduation date.
- 4. Participate in 20 (twenty) hours of community service. If 20 hours of service is not completed by the submission deadline, applicants have until April 14<sup>th</sup> of their graduating year to submit hours to the contact above to qualify for a scholarship.
- 5. Provide academic transcripts (or equivalent).
- 6. Documentation of continuing education.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Scholarship information and application forms may be obtained in the Hide-A-Way Lake Office prior to the summer of the graduating academic year.
- Additional scholarships may also be awarded for subsequent years up to a total of four while the
  applicant is an undergraduate or equivalent. Criteria for an additional award will be similar to
  those above.
- Application for a scholarship does not guarantee a scholarship award.
- Scholarship funds may be used by the student as needed for post-high school educational/vocational expenses.
- Academic achievement and participation in high school activities will be considered.
- Scholarships are given on the basis that the applicant completes the academic year or receive a degree/certificate of completion. Dropping out of the school prior to that will cause the scholarship to become void and may require the recipient to repay current scholarship funds.

### **GUIDELINES:**

- A. Students must participate in a minimum of 20 hours of community service. Service in Hide-A-Way Lake is preferred but not necessary.
- B. APPLICATION for the scholarship (included in the Scholarship Packet) must be submitted by April 14<sup>th</sup> of the student's graduating year for review by the Scholarship Committee. For those who wish to apply based on Number 3 above, the deadline is one year after graduation.
- C. Scholarships will be awarded at the June meeting of the Hide-A-Way Lake, Inc. Board.
