MANAGER'S REPORT - Bruce Devillier

- 1. On August 10, 2023, the petition to raise our water system water rate was filed with the Mississippi Public Service Commission. The Notice to Customers was sent out on August 28, 2023, with the monthly billing statements. The base rate of 3,000 gallons will change to \$19.00 (previously \$16.25) and \$6.00 (previously \$3.50) per 1,000 gallons after the initial 3,000 base gallons. We are awaiting the Mississippi Public Service Commission's review/approval.
- On August 28, 2023, the HAWL Office signed an engagement letter of services for the fiscal year
 of operations of October 1, 2022, to September 30, 2023, for CPA review/financial statements/tax
 returns with Angela Hertzog of Grantham Poole Certified Public Accountants. Kent Whitfield's CPA
 Firm can no longer perform our audits/reviews.
- 3. On August 21, 2023, an agreement was made with the original developer of our community, Hide-A-Way Lake, Inc., regarding the civil case concerning the 119.59 acres of land on the north side of our community. A resolution is forthcoming in this meeting.

- 4. Bids were opened on August 30, 2023, for painting the interior and exterior of both pressure tanks (13,000 gallons and 20,000 gallons) and to pressure wash the outside with inspection of the 200,000 gallon water tower. A resolution is forthcoming to award this project in this meeting.
- 5. On September 11, 2023, an emergency purchase and installation occurred of two 8" valves that control the 20,000 pressure tank with our water system from Ferguson Water Supply and Lyman Well Service. A resolution is forthcoming.
- 6. Bid proposals were received last month to bulkhead the remaining marina lake wall at the Lodge and to bulkhead and replace the existing older docks at the West Marina. A resolution is forthcoming to award this project in this meeting.
- 7. The 2014 Ford F-150 had a tune up last month at Mike's Dependable Automotive for a total cost of \$1,219.77.
- 8. Effective October 2, 2023, Southgate will be open for a trial period Monday Friday continually from 5:00 am 9:00 pm. We will collect all vehicle usage data to finalize if the hours of operation will be adjusted. This trial period is budgeted for 60 90 days.
- 9. The Owner Inspection of the dam/spillway was completed and the Emergency Response Plan was updated. Both were submitted to the MDEQ for review.
- 10. The HAWL Flea Market is scheduled for Saturday, October 21, 2023, for property owners. A breakfast buffet is also planned with Waters Edge.
- 11. A Community Meet and Greet with the General Manager, Blood Drive, and Goodwill Express Donation Station are scheduled for Saturday, November 4, 2023. See *Echoes* and the HAWL website for more information.

An increase in water flow, erosion, and flooding could potentially take place as well as loss of fish, increased silt, and decrease property values.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Board of Directors of Hide-A-Way Lake Club, Inc. approves Robin Montalbano, President of Hide-A-Way Lake Club, Inc. to sign all documents for the purchase of the 119.59 acres of undeveloped land in the north section adjacent of our community for the purchase price of two hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$275,000.00) and release of the civil case. The purchase includes a restriction against commercial or residential development on this parcel for 20 years.

A resolution whereby the Board of Directors of Hide-A-Way Lake Club, Inc. approves the emergency purchase and installation of the two 8" gate valves that control the 20,000 gallon pressure tank with our water system.

WHEREAS when preparing the 20,000 gallon pressure tank for maintenance and painting, it was discovered that both of the 1992 8" gate valves would not seal to complete this maintenance to the 20,000 pressure tank. Both Well #3 and Well #4 gate valves had to be shut so the pressure tank would seal, which means both Well #3 and #4 were taken offline. Therefore, Well #2 pumped only 200 gallons per minute and cut our water distribution very low to the gallons needed for the system, compared to normal pump rate of 550 – 700 gallons per minute.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Board of Directors of Hide-A-Way Lake Club, Inc. approves the emergency purchase of two new 8" gate valves from Ferguson Water Supply for \$3,227.63 and Lyman Well Service to install the valves for \$3,500.00.


